
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FEAST OF CATHEDRAL OF HOLY ETCHMIADZIN



THE WAY OF CHRISTIANIZATION OF THE ARMENIAN NATION

This past week, as the Armenian Church and the Armenian Christian Nation, we were walking the paths of our Christian identity. And today we are renewing the centuries-old faith we inherited from the founders of our Christian roots. In the way of faith we join the great testimony of the fearless and invincible martyrdom of the saints, and see that the word of Christ and the light of the gospel remove the darkness from our lives, enlighten our minds, and set a pure and prayerful heart within us to worship the Holy Trinity in spirit and in truth.

One of the most celebrated feasts of the Armenian Church is the day when the Cathedral of Holy Etchmiadzin was established, according to the inspired vision of St. Gregory the Illuminator.

According to tradition, and haging-raphic sources, following the declaration of Christianity as the Official Religion of Armenia in 301 AD, St. Gregory has a famous vision, wherein the Only Begotten Son of God – Jesus Christ,



descends from Heaven, his face lit aglow, and with the strike of a golden hammer designates the site where the Mother Cathedral for the entire Armenian nation is to be founded. Hence, the name of the spiritual center for the Armenians, "Etchmiadzin", means "the Descent of the Only Begotten" (Etch - descent, mionly, dzin - begotten.)

St. Gregory relayed the story about his vision to the Armenian King Tiridates, under whose royal auspices and support the Cathedral of Holy Etchmiadzin was built. King Tiridates and Queen Ashkhen participated in the construction, as did the entire capital city of Vagharshapat by bringing stones from the biblical mountain of Ararat to lay the foundations. In the site marked by Christ, a Holy Altar of Descent was built.

According of Patriarch Malachia Ormanian, from the days of her establishment, the Cathedral of Holy Etchmiadzin has been the residence of the Supreme Patriarch and Catholicos of All Armenians. Thus, it is the Mother See of the Armenian Church,



and as such, her universal, spiritual and administrative headquarters.

Another title bestowed upon the cathedral is "Catholic" - not to be confused with the Roman Catholic faith. Catholic is a Greek word meaning "Universal". Theologically, the cathedral has been called "catholic" as a description of the catholicity (universality) of the Church.

The feast of the Cathedral of Holy Etchmiadzin is celebrated 64 days following Easter. A Divine Liturgy is celebrated, and during services, a special hymn is sung, written by the eighth century Catholicos Sahak of Dzorap, telling of St. Gregory's vision and the Cathedral's construction.

The only begotten of the Father descended and the light of glory with Him,

The voices resounded from the depths of hell.

Having seen the great light,

our patriarch Gregory told the converted king with joy:

Come let us build the Altar of light,

for there the Light dawned upon us in Armenia.

GUIDANCE ON SUNDAY'S DIVINE LITURGY

SCRIPTURE READING

The reader of the Holy Scripture is Nina Marifian.

Alleluia, Alleluia. This is the day which the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it. O give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his steadfast love endures forever!

The reading is from the Letter of the St. Paul to the Hebrews (9:1-10)

Now even the first covenant had regulations for worship and an earthly sanctuary. For a tent was prepared, the outer one, in which were the lampstand and the table and the bread of the Presence; it is called the Holy Place. Behind the second curtain stood a tent called the Holy of Holies, having the golden altar of incense and the ark of the covenant covered on all sides with gold, which contained a golden urn holding the manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant; above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat. Of these things we cannot now speak in detail.

These preparations having thus been made, the priests go continually into the outer tent, performing their ritual duties; but into the second only the high priest goes, and he but once a year, and not without taking blood which he offers for himself and for the errors of the people. By this the Holy Spirit indicates that the way into the sanctuary is not yet opened as long as the outer tent is still standing (which is symbolic for the present age). According to this arrangement, gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot perfect the conscience of the worshiper, but deal only with food and drink and various ablutions, regulations for the body imposed until the time of reformation.


Alleluia, Alleluia. How lovely is your dwelling place, O Lord of hosts! My soul longs, indeed it faints for the courts of the Lord.
